Scratch is an educational programming language developed by the Lifelong Kindergarten group at the MIT Media Lab for elementary and middle school children. Students will experiment with the concepts of versatile computer programming by snapping together visual programming blocks to develop their own interactive stories, animations, games, music, and art. The class will have an account on the scratch website where their projects can be uploaded for their families and friends to see at home! Scratch is a free programming language which the students can download at home and continue experimenting with outside of class.

## **SPANISH**
